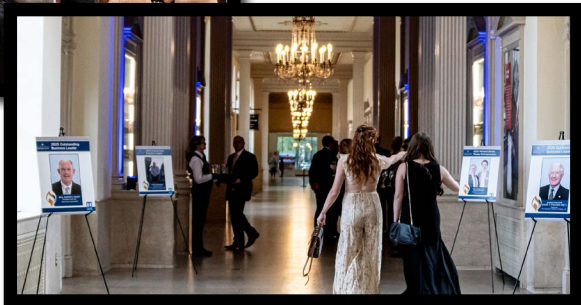

Paul Glantz is Co-Founder and Chairman Emeritus of Michigan-based Emagine Entertainment, Inc., which operates 27 theaters in Michigan, Indiana, Illinois, Wisconsin, and Minnesota. Emagine has grown from one screen with 265 seats in 1989 to become the 10th largest theater operator in North America and, throughout that time, Paul has been dedicated to ensuring that his guests enjoy an exemplary entertainment experience. Most recently, Emagine was voted number one in the industry for two years running in a nationwide Market Force survey on customer loyalty, value, and trust.

Paul holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration with high distinction from Wayne State University, and a Master of Science degree in taxation from Walsh College. Paul also holds an honorary associate's degree from Schoolcraft College and an honorary Doctor of Laws from Walsh College. He has been recognized by both his alma maters, Walsh College and Wayne State, with their Distinguished Alumni Awards. In addition, he was awarded Wayne State's Irvin D. Reid Honors College's first-ever Pillar Award, and he has been recognized by Ernst & Young as a Michigan and Northwest Ohio Entrepreneur of the Year.

Paul is an active and engaged member of the community. In addition to his role at Emagine, he currently serves on the Executive Committee of the Detroit Regional Chamber of Commerce, the boards of directors for MICPA and Cinema United, and the Finance Committee for Gleaners Community Food Bank of SE Michigan. He is an emeritus member of the Board of Visitors of Wayne State University's Mike Ilitch School of Business.

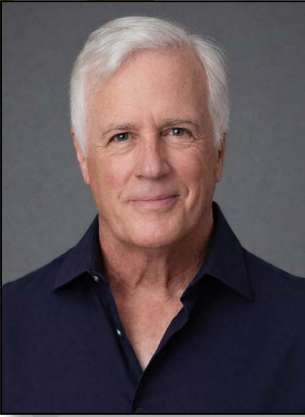

Jen Panning is a business leader and entrepreneur whose career reflects a lifelong commitment to hard work, craftsmanship, and opportunity. Raised in Hartland, Michigan, she developed an early entrepreneurial spirit, launching her first business, a newspaper route, at just nine years old, where she gained firsthand experience in customer service, billing, and operations.

Encouraged to pursue higher education, Jen found her path at Northwood University, where she worked her way through college with the help of a private donor scholarship. After beginning her career in the corporate world, she soon realized her passion for ownership and, in 1995, co-founded Artisan Tile Inc. with her late husband, Scott, using a small loan and a borrowed truck.

Under Jen's leadership, Artisan Tile grew into one of Michigan's premier specialty contractors, contributing to major projects including Detroit Metropolitan Airport, Little Caesars Arena, the Shinola Hotel, and the GM Renaissance Center, as well as numerous universities across the state. She credits the company's success to the exceptional craftsmanship of its crews and the strong foundation built alongside her late husband and father.

Deeply committed to giving back, Jen and Scott established the Artisan Tile Endowed Scholarship at Northwood University to support middle-income students. She also founded Light of the World Academy, reflecting her dedication to faith, education, and community. Today, Jen continues to lead with purpose while remaining most proud of her family and the opportunities she has helped create for others.

Danny Sullivan is an American motorsports icon whose remarkable career behind the wheel made him one of the most celebrated drivers of his generation.

Best known for his legendary “spin and win” victory at the 1985 Indianapolis 500, Sullivan went on to dominate the 1988 CART IndyCar World Series Championship with five wins, clinching the title with a race to spare. Over the course of his career, he earned 17 wins in the CART IndyCar World Series, achieved the IndyCar Triple Crown by winning at Indianapolis, Michigan, and Pocono, and claimed victory at the 1994 Rolex 24 at Daytona. One of a select few drivers to have competed across an extraordinary range of series and events, Sullivan’s résumé spans Formula One, IndyCar, NASCAR, DTM, the Baja 1000, and the 24 Hours of Le Mans. His international reach extended to Formula One, where he competed in the 1983 season with the Tyrrell team, and he remains a member of the F1 Grand Prix Drivers Club.

Beyond the track, Sullivan has remained a prominent figure in motorsports. He served as a television commentator for ABC/ESPN, has represented drivers on Formula One stewards’ panels as a FIA Formula One Race Steward, and played an instrumental role in the Red Bull Driver Search program, helping bring American drivers to Formula One. He also served as a judge for the Nissan GT Academy and has worked on driver development projects with multiple car manufacturers. He was inducted into the Motorsports Hall of Fame in 2010.

Today, Danny serves as a Senior Advisor at Aviation Partners Global Services (APGS), specializing in the defense and commercial aviation sectors, and he remains an active partner in several global business ventures across the sports, aviation, and automotive industries.

Linzie Venegas is a second generation Owner-Operator of Ideal Group, one of Michigan's leading family-owned businesses. As Chief Operating Officer, Linzie oversees the operations and strategic direction of seven companies that generate more than \$650 million in annual revenue and employ approximately 1,000 people.

Her journey began with stuffing envelopes at just 8 years old. Over the years, she has worked across nearly every part of the organization, from accounting and sales to marketing and company president. These experiences gave her a deep understanding of Ideal Group's operations, culture, and customers. Alongside her brother, Jesse, she is guiding Ideal's transition from first- to second-generation leadership, carrying forward the legacy of their father, Frank Venegas Jr.

Beyond her work at Ideal, Linzie is a Cranbrook Schools Trustee, Vice Chair of the Cranbrook Institute of Science, and Board Member for the Michigan Israel Business Accelerator. She also teaches in Dartmouth's Tuck School of Business "Building a Successful Business" executive education program, helping entrepreneurs scale and strengthen their companies.

Deeply committed to her community, Linzie actively supports education and opportunity initiatives in Southwest Detroit, including Holy Redeemer Grade School, Detroit Cristo Rey High School, and the Detroit Hispanic Development Corporation.

Linzie was named among Crain's Detroit Business' "40 Under 40" in 2018 and honored in DBusiness Magazine's "Powered by Women" in 2024. Most recently, she and Jesse were selected as EY's 2025 Entrepreneurs of the Year for the Michigan and Northwest Ohio region.

Warren's 50-year automotive career began at age 21, carrying forward a family legacy that began in 1965, when his father opened Florida's first Toyota dealership.

Under Warren's leadership, the company is known for superior products, exceptional service, and a dedicated team with an average tenure of 12-plus years. His commitment extends beyond business, as he generously supports numerous philanthropic organizations, including Mount Sinai Medical Center, March of Dimes, Alzheimer's Association, and the Greater Miami Jewish Foundation.

Warren's excellence has been recognized with prestigious honors, including the TIME Magazine Quality Dealer Award, the J.D. 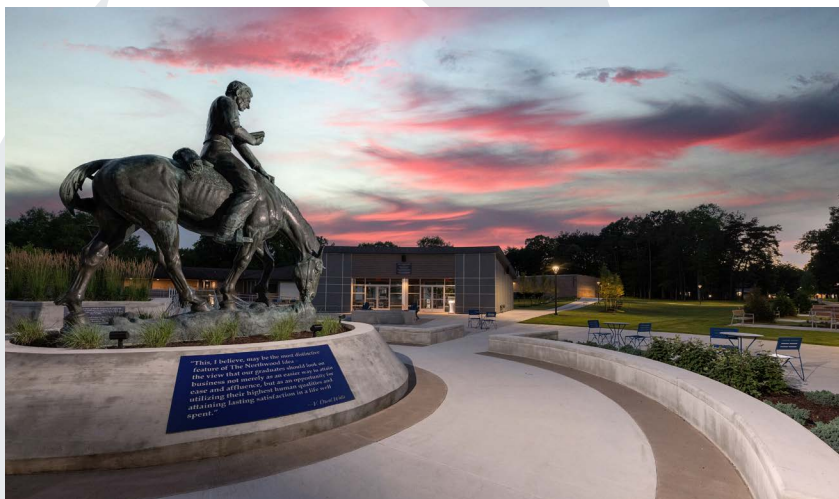
