## **Attributes**

At Northwood, we emphasize qualitative personal development. Through purposeful programming and course offerings, we develop individuals who can explain their personal values; appreciate the aesthetic, creative, and spiritual elements of life; seek lifelong education; and be action-oriented, effective self-evaluators. These attributes encompass our holistic approach to developing the future leaders of a global free-enterprise society.

## Significance of the Mace

The mace, carried proudly at the head of our academic procession, is emblematic of the ethics and ideals for which Northwood University stands.

The mace is made of brass for strength and silvered for beauty. The three interlocking pieces total a little over three feet in length and each of the three pieces represents a Northwood University idea. At the top is the flame of learning.

The bottom section is emblematic of the strength of Northwood University's base, co-founders Arthur E. Turner and R. Gary Stauffer. Their names are engraved here as is the founding date.

The two insignia are an acorn and an oak leaf. The acorn symbolizes one of our greatest strengths and richest resources—our young people. The oak leaf implies that the acorn's value is in the tree that grows straight and a fundamental purpose of the Northwood Idea is the productive development of that latent strength.

The middle section stands for our country, with a sheaf of wheat—the rich promise of our land; and the American flag—the emblem of our country's free enterprise principle which turns rich potential into vital yield.

The top section has a plant with blossoms and a cross with the crown and its promise.

When not leading the academic procession, the three tiers can be separated and placed in a walnut base—each tier is designed to hold the flag it symbolizes.

The Northwood mace was designed and donated to the college in its earliest days by Dr. and Mrs. C. W. Whitston of California.

## The Flags on Display

The 96 colorful flags displayed on campus represent the countries of Northwood students, both past and present, who have been enrolled on the Michigan Campus since 1990. The students have contributed to an international atmosphere and an opportunity for close personal relationships which lead to special international understanding.



## Significance of Academic Regalia

The significance of academic regalia is determined especially by the sleeves and hoods.

Doctors wear the round bell sleeves; the gown is faced down the front and barred on the sleeves with black velvet or color indicating the degree; the doctor's hood is large. The doctor may, if he or she so chooses, wear the gold tassel on his or her cap.

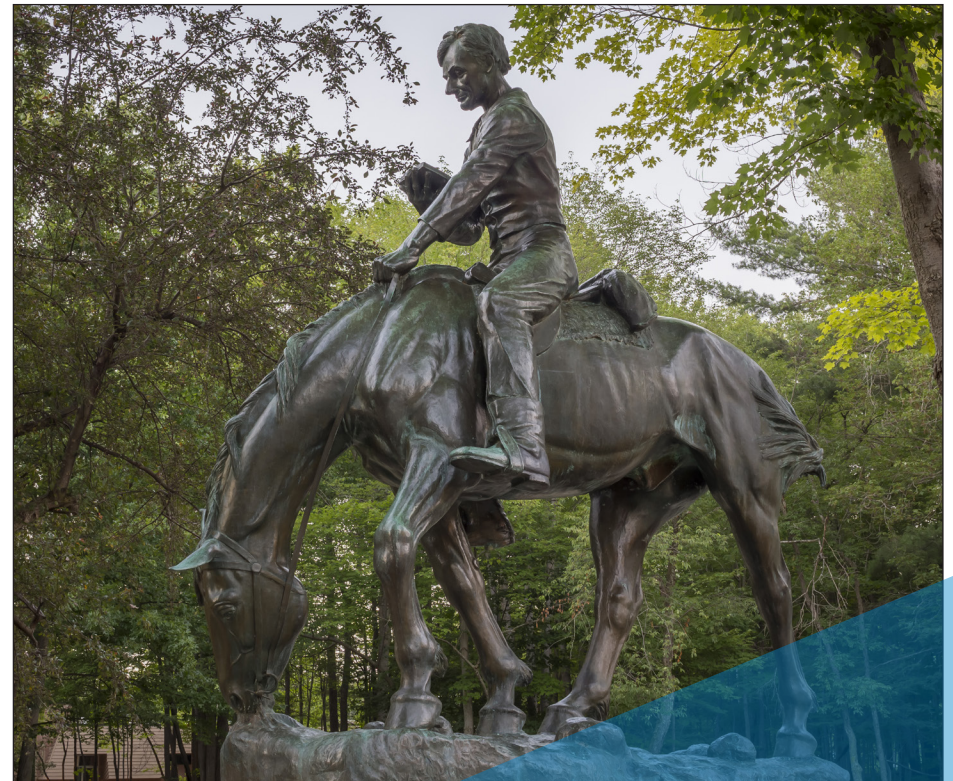
Masters wear the long, closed sleeve, with a slit near the upper part of the arm; the master's hood is of more moderate size.

Bachelors and associates wear the long or pointed sleeve.

Hoods are lined with the colors of the institutions granting the degree, or with which the wearer is connected, and are trimmed with velvet of the color distinctive of the degree—for example, humanities and social science, white; philosophy, blue; science, golden yellow; music, pink; engineering, orange; education, light blue; business and public management, drab; laws, purple.

The navy graduation stole with the white academic seal is worn around the neck to represent student achievement and success.

The red, white and blue cords recognize active military and veteran graduates.

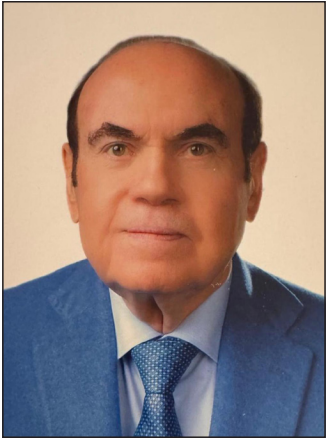

## **Dr. Gabriel Benzecry**

David E. Fry Professor of Free Market Economics, Northwood University

Dr. Gabriel Benzecry is the David E. Fry Professor of Free Market Economics at Northwood University and a respected scholar of Austrian economics and the history of economic thought. Originally from Brazil, he earned his PhD and Master of Arts in Economics from Middle Tennessee State University and his bachelor's degree in economics from Wake Forest University, where he also studied philosophy and entrepreneurship.

His research focuses on the ideas of influential economists such as F.A. Hayek and Ludwig von Mises and has been published in leading academic journals, including *History of Political Economy* and the *Journal of the History of Economic Thought*.

Dr. Benzecry is known for a teaching philosophy grounded in personalized mentorship, intellectual independence, and a commitment to helping students understand the principles of personal responsibility within a free-enterprise system. A strong advocate for academic freedom, he fosters an environment where rigorous inquiry, open debate, and the pursuit of truth are central to the educational experience.

## **Rita Case**

CEO and Owner, The Rick Case Automotive Group

Rita Case is President, CEO, and Owner of The Rick Case Automotive Group, the largest U.S. auto retail group owned and operated by a woman. Her career reflects a strong drive to build, lead, and succeed in a traditionally male dominated industry.

Raised in a business focused family, at a young age Rita began working at her parents' dealership, the first Honda dealership in the United States. After graduating from the University of California, she returned determined to prove that women can succeed as dealers. That determination shaped a career defined by resilience, vision, and growth. In 1977, she met Rick Case at a Honda meeting, and together they built one of the most successful automotive groups in the country.

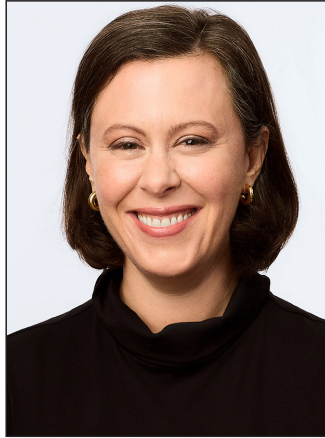
Her leadership has earned national recognition, including 2026 Cox Automotive Woman of the Year, 2024 TIME Dealer of the Year, USA Today National Dealer of the Year, and Automotive News Outstanding Women in the Auto Industry. She has also received honors such as the Horatio Alger Award, Ernst and Young Entrepreneur of the Year, and induction into Nova Southeastern University's H. Wayne Huizenga Entrepreneur Hall of Fame.

Beyond business, Rita has strengthened institutions through board service with the Miami Branch of the Federal Reserve, Cleveland Clinic Florida, Nova Southeastern University, Florida Council of 100, and the Horatio Alger Association. Her philanthropic work focuses on advancing education and improving community health and safety, with more than 125 million dollars raised for South Florida organizations.

## **Mary Kissel**

Executive Vice President and Senior Policy Advisor, Stephens, Inc.

Mary Kissel is a senior executive and foreign policy expert with more than two decades of experience advising political leaders, Fortune 500 CEOs, and institutional investors on geopolitics, markets, and strategy. She is a Nonresident Senior Fellow at the Hudson Institute in Washington, D.C., and serves on the boards of QXO, Inc. and RXO, Inc., both New York Stock Exchange-listed companies.

Previously, she founded and led the policy advisory practice at Stephens, Inc. From 2018 to 2021, she served as Senior Advisor to the U.S. Secretary of State, providing strategic counsel on major foreign policy initiatives, managing special projects, and representing the United States in more than 60 countries. She played a key role in the reorientation of U.S.-China relations and in the establishment of the Commission on Unalienable Rights.

Earlier in her career, Ms. Kissel spent 14 years with The Wall Street Journal, serving as Editorial Page Editor for Asia-Pacific in Hong Kong and later as a member of the editorial board in New York. She began her professional career at Goldman Sachs in New York and London.

Ms. Kissel is a member of the Council on Foreign Relations and a director of the American Australian Council. Her commentary has appeared on television, radio, and podcasts worldwide, and her writing has been published in leading international publications. She holds degrees from Harvard University and the Johns Hopkins University School of Advanced International Studies.

# ABOUT NORTHWOOD UNIVERSITY

## Founded for a Purpose

Established in 1959 during a period of significant national growth and innovation, Northwood University was created to address the need for educating leaders capable of building businesses, fostering opportunity, and strengthening the nation through free enterprise.

Founders Arthur E. Turner and R. Gary Stauffer maintained that higher education should equip students not only for professional success but also to lead lives characterized by responsibility, productivity, and meaningful impact.

## The Northwood Idea

Northwood University is guided by a differentiating philosophy, The Northwood Idea, which encompasses enduring principles such as individual freedom and responsibility, the importance of free enterprise, earned success, and moral law with limited government.

These ideals remain central to the University's mission and underpin Northwood's identity as America's Free Enterprise University.
