Supporting Endowed Student Scholarships, Removing Barriers to Free-Enterprise



Philanthropic Opportunities

The Liberty Fund

Northwood University believes that any qualified young man or woman should be able to receive the lifedefining experience of education regardless of economic means. The *When We Are Free* campaign seeks generous benefactors who will provide endowed and named scholarships at the following levels:

Endowed Full-Tuition Scholarships

\$5,000,000 - will provide \$225,000 annually \$2,500,000 - will provide \$112,500 annually \$1,500,000 - will provide \$67,500 annually \$1,000,000 - will provide \$45,000 annually \$750,000 - will provide \$33,750 annually

Endowed Leadership Scholarships

\$500,000 - will provide \$22,500 annually \$250,000 - will provide \$11,250 annually

Endowed Inspiration Scholarships

\$100,000 - will provide \$4,500 annually \$75,000 - will provide \$3,375 annually \$50,000 - will provide \$2,250 annually
